Rules of Play

- Ticket purchasers must be 19 years of age or older. If a winning ticket bears a minor's name, the prize will be lawfully delivered on behalf of the minor to the minor's parent, legal guardian or trustee.
- Each pay period, Island Health HR provides the Campbell River Hospital Foundation with a list of payroll deduction lotto participants. Only these participants will be eligible for that draw.
- If you do not work in the pay period you do not play
- Upon receipt of your consent is received by the Campbell River Hospital Foundation, a notification will be sent via email. Because of cut-off dates for Island Health pay periods, it may take several weeks before payroll deductions begin.
- Players will be notified of updates or changes to Payday Lotto via email. Please provide a valid email address. You are responsible for keeping your contact information up to date.
- Winners are required to present their Island Health identification along with one other piece of photo identification to receive their cheque from the Campbell River Hospital Foundation
- Participants will be entered into the eligible draw period May 15, 2018 to May 28, 2019
- Requests to leave the lotto are at the discretion of the employee. To withdraw your name from the Campbell River Hospital Foundation staff payday lotto, you must notify our office in writing. Your request to withdraw is then forwarded to Island Health HR. Because of cut-off dates for Island Health pay periods, it may take several weeks before the withdrawal is complete.
- Please note that the annual cost of lotto participation is not considered a charitable donation by the Canada Revenue Agency and is therefore not eligible for a tax receipt.
- The Campbell River Hospital Foundation is committed to protecting your privacy. Information provided is for internal use only. We will not sell trade or rent your personal information.
- Campbell River Hospital Foundation staff is not eligible to play Payday Lotto.
